## **PSSH 412: INTERNATIONAL LAW**

1. You have been approached for advice by members of Zvibwidoland Liberation Front (ZLF). Zvibwidoland area is a province of Zvavanhu state. Zvibwidoland is populated by people who are ethnically and culturally distinct from the rest of Zvavanhu state. The ZLF claims to represent the people of Zvibwidoland and controls most of the province as a result of successful struggle (so far) against the Zvavanhu government.

Advise on whether the right to self-determination under international law applies in the context of Zvibwido people, and discuss the criteria an entity must satisfy in order to qualify as a state.

2. Define international law. How does it differ with all other forms of law?
3. Discuss the varied sources of international law.
4. Examine the nature and extent of sovereign immunity.
5. 'The invasion of Ukraine by Russia is meant to de-Nazify and de-militarize Kyiv'. Can there be such a justification under international law.
