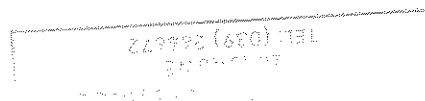

6. Analyse the assertion that public participation and environmental justice are not prioritised in the mainstream planning legislation and practice.
