#### **QUESTION 4**

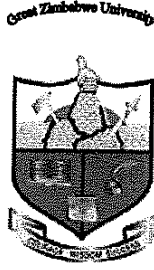
Considering the North versus South development discourse, discuss the major contrasts underlying trade liberalization and protectionism as distinct approaches to international trade.

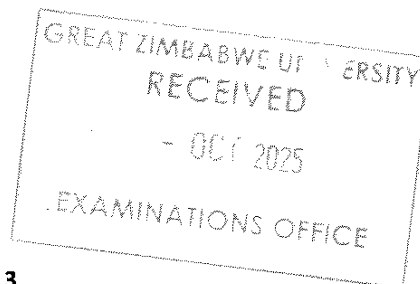
